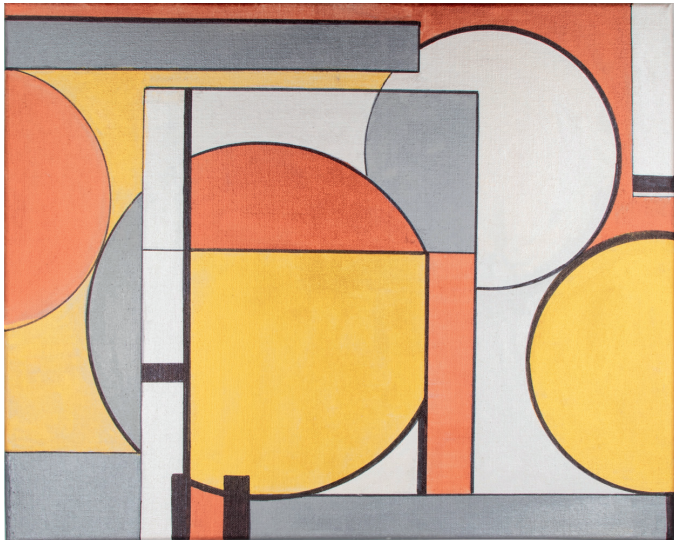


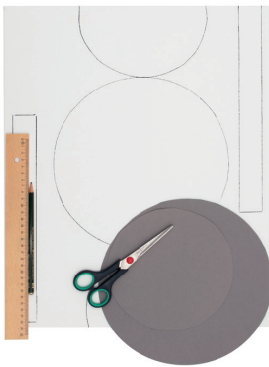
Brilliant colours and lively shapes



Material list – Brilliant colours

6 0010 013	Canvas frame 40x50 cm
6 2101 630	Mica-colour pigments white
6 2101 635	Mica-colour pigments silver colour
6 2101 636	Mica-colour pigments gold colour
6 2101 637	Mica-colour pigments copper colour
6 8090 813	Craft glue
6 1102 757	Palette
6 1226 400	Grey cardboard

You will also need a pencil, ruler, various brushes, templates and a permanent marker.



1. Cut out various templates from grey cardboard. Arrange them on the stretcher frame and draw the patterns in pencil.

2. Mix craft glue with mica colour pigments in the palette. Apply these mixtures to the pattern with the brushes as desired and leave to dry.



3. Then reinforce the contours with a permanent marker. You can use the cardboard templates to colour in the patterns more easily and add accents.

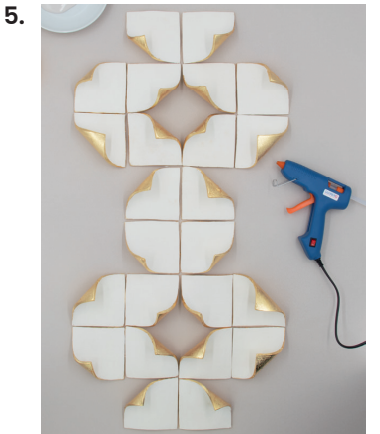

Simple elegance



1. First make the decorative elements. To do this, place 3 mm thick pieces of wood on the right and left of the foam rubber plate. Knead Keramilight into a thick roll and place it in the centre. Use the acrylic roller to roll the modelling clay out flat (3 mm). If the modelling clay is brittle, put a few drops of water on your fingertips and knead the clay.



2.1. Make a 10x10 cm template, place it on the rolled out Keramilight and cut out a plate.

2.2. Place the plate in the centre of the foam rubber plate. Fold in one corner of the foam rubber sheet and secure the sheet with a clothes peg. This gives the Keramilight panel its arch. Leave to dry for approx. 12 hours.

3. Then remove the decorative element. Then sand the edges.

4. Apply the application milk to the back and edges and leave to dry for approx. half an hour. Then apply the metal leaf and press on with a soft brush. Remove any excess metal leaf. Protect the applied metal leaf with the varnish.

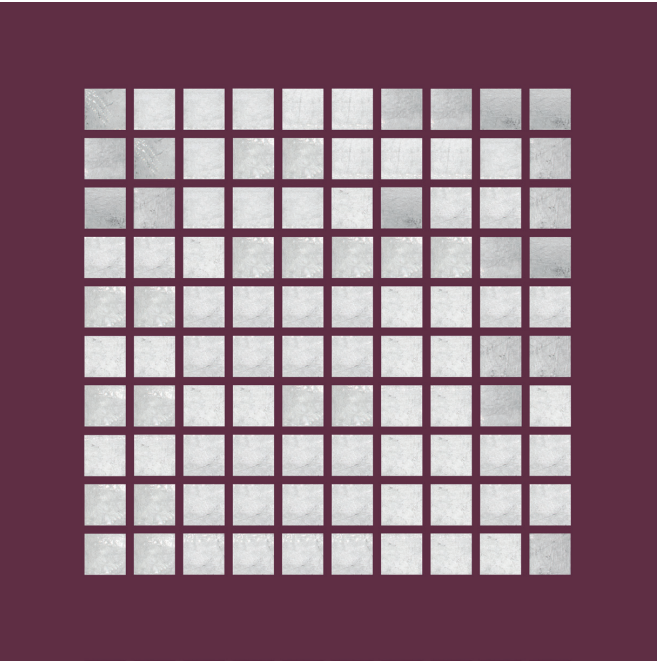
5. Paint the stretcher frame with the desired acrylic colour. Fix the decorative elements with hot glue.

6 8782	011	Application milk for metal leaf
6 8782	012	Varnish for metal leaf
6 2136	100	Sandpaper

6 2200	402	Clothes pegs
6 2245	503	Craft rubber, skin colour
6 2250	309	Round wooden sticks, diam. 3mm

You will also need a knife, acrylic paints, soft brush for the metal leaf and a large brush to apply the acrylic paint evenly.
